Foreword

For Hoffnung leben, 2025 was a year characterised by **continuity and further development**. We were able to continue and build on many of our initiatives, whilst others were launched for the first time.

Together with our volunteers, members, funding partners and our Greek partner organisation, Ariadni Lesvos, we were able to support people with experience of displacement and migration on **their journey towards a self-determined life – through education, social interaction and personal support**.

A particular focus was placed on **expanding our digital educational provision**. **EcoTeamEurope** was launched as a new learning platform for children and young people. At the same time, we further developed our online provision in the areas of German language learning, integration and community engagement, and laid the foundations for its further expansion.

We also deepened **our collaboration with Ariadni Lesvos**. Together, we were able to empower women, support children and accompany families – both on Lesbos and after their onward journey to Germany or other European countries.

What sets **our work** apart is not large-scale programmes, but **reliable relationships**. We have now been supporting some children, young people and families for around four years. Trust does not grow within the confines of a single project, but through continuity, shared experiences and mutual learning.

We would like to extend our heartfelt thanks to all our members, volunteers, funding partners and donors. Your support makes our work possible.

Our approach and how we work



Hoffnung leben e.V. supports people with experience of displacement and migration on their journey towards a self-determined life. In doing so, we do not view people as recipients of aid, but as **individuals with their own abilities, experiences and potential**.

Our work is based on the belief that **education, interaction and mutual trust** enable lasting change. That is why we create spaces where people can learn from one another, develop their strengths and gain new perspectives.

We deliberately focus on **small groups, personal relationships and individual support**. Reliability and stable relationships are particularly valuable for people who have experienced displacement, loss and many goodbyes.

Our programmes are aimed at people from different backgrounds, of different ages and in various life situations.

Together with our partner organisation, Ariadni Lesvos, we combine educational programmes, personal support and collaborative learning – on Lesbos, in Germany and online.



Our work is characterised by **respect, voluntary participation and interaction on an equal footing**. We support people, whilst at the same time learning from their experiences and perspectives. This fosters relationships that enrich both sides.

Through our projects, **we contribute to several of the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs):**

- **SDG 4 – Quality Education**
through language support, environmental education and digital learning programmes.
- **SDG 5 – Gender Equality**
through educational programmes and discussion forums aimed at empowering women and girls.
- **SDG 10 – Reduced Inequalities**
through education, guidance and long-term support.
- **SDG 16 – Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions**
through information, guidance and the teaching of democratic values and rights.
- **SDG 17 – Partnerships for the Goals**
through close collaboration with Ariadni Lesvos, funding partners and volunteers.



In Germany

Our work in Germany begins for many people before their arrival. Many contacts are established already on Lesbos and remain in place even after they continue their journey. Therefore, our work includes not only educational offerings but also family visits as well as personal information and ongoing accompaniment.

German, Integration and Connection



Language opens **doors to education, work and participation in society**. That is why we continued our online German classes throughout 2025 and developed the programme further in terms of content.

Classes were held in **small groups** and tailored to each participant's individual language level. Alongside beginner courses, we also offered conversation groups for learners with more advanced German skills. Where needed, we additionally supported participants with individual exam preparation.

Yet language learning was not the only focus. The regular gatherings provided space for questions about everyday life in Germany, for mutual exchange and shared learning. Many participants already knew each other from joint activities on Lesbos and were able to maintain these connections even after moving on.

Thanks to a grant, we were able to purchase learning materials and work tools as well as to fund internet access for individual participants. This made it easier for them to take part in our online programmes.

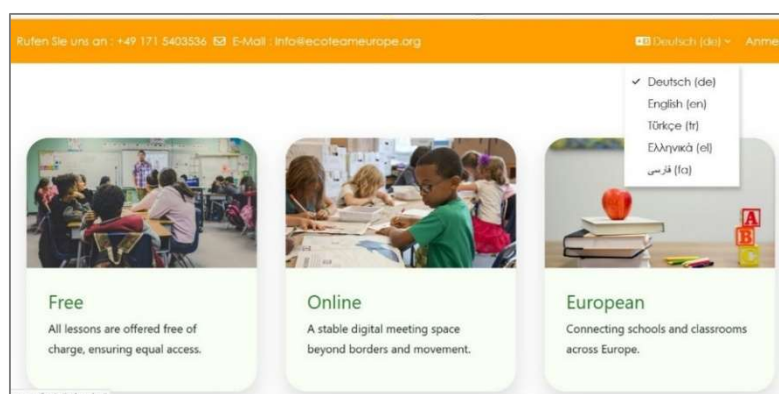
EcoTeamEurope – Nature connects

A particular focus in 2025 was **building the digital learning platform** EcoTeamEurope. With financial support, we established the technical foundations, developed teaching materials and created the first content.

We started with one weekly group of seven children and young people. Together they explored **nature, the environment, sustainability and climate protection**. At the same time, the classes gave them the opportunity to practise **English**, maintain international **friendships** and make new connections.



A central concern of EcoTeamEurope is keeping children and young people connected with one another even after they have moved on. This way, the experiences from the EcoKids on Lesbos can continue in an international learning environment. For 2026, we plan to set up a second group.



Family Visits – Continuing Relationships



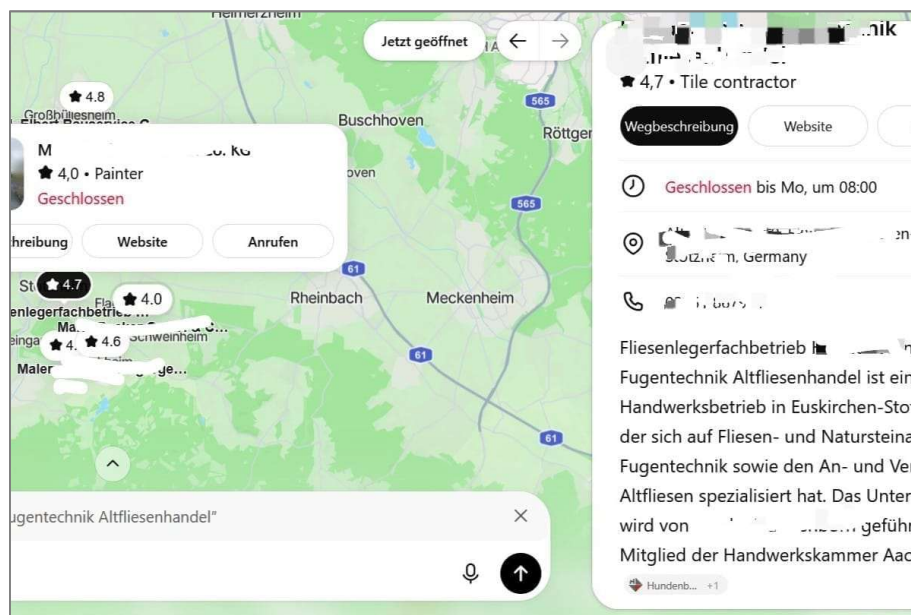
Many people we first meet on Lesbos go on to build a new life in Germany after moving on. Wherever possible, **we visit families there in person**. These **personal encounters help us better understand their current situation** and consider together what kind of support might be helpful.

The visits are **about nurturing relationships**. They create space for open conversations and give us insight into the challenges of everyday life – such as settling into a new environment, children starting school, or questions about training and work.

For many families, it is **encouraging** to experience that the connection remains even after they have moved on. In this way, initial encounters can grow into long-term relationships that adapt to each family's changing circumstances.

Information, Guidance and Personal Support

Not all support takes place within the framework of a fixed programme. Many people turn to us with questions about life in Germany – for example about language courses, training opportunities, authorities, or suitable counselling services.



Often a pointer to the right contact person is enough. But sometimes we also accompany people over a longer period and consider together what next steps might make sense. We do not see our role as prescribing solutions, but rather empowering people and giving them orientation so that they can shape their own path independently.

International Cooperation with Ariadni Lesvos



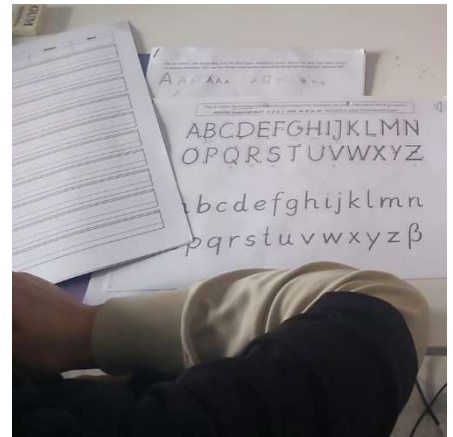
The cooperation between Hoffnung leben e.V. and Ariadni Lesvos has **grown over many years**. Both organisations are legally and financially independent, yet they work closely together and complement each other in their respective areas of activity.

In 2025, regular professional exchange and further developing joint educational and support programmes were at the centre of our work. Hoffnung leben e.V. and Ariadni Lesvos brought their different experiences and expertise to the partnership. The initiatives "German & Integration" and "Let's Talk about Europe" from Hoffnung leben e.V. were implemented in the premises of Ariadni Lesvos.

German Language Programmes on Lesbos

In the first half of 2025, three beginner **German courses** were held on Lesbos, each with around seven participants. The aim was to teach basic language skills and facilitate access to further educational opportunities.

In late autumn, the programme was discontinued. On the one hand, the needs of the people on Lesbos had changed. On the other hand, we wanted to avoid raising expectations of onward migration to German-speaking countries through a permanent German course offering. The freed-up resources could thus be redirected towards other educational programmes.



Let's Talk about – Education, Exchange and Counselling for Women



Also in 2025, "Let's Talk about" continued as a low-threshold **educational and conversation programme for women and girls**. The regular meetings at the Ariadni house provided a safe space for information, exchange and mutual support.

Topics focused on **women's health, family planning, equal rights, rights within the European Union**, as well as **questions about everyday life and participation in society**. The discussion groups enabled participants to share experiences, learn from each other and strengthen their own agency and options for action.

Developing Projects Together

The close cooperation was also reflected in 2025 through further developing existing programmes. Already on Lesbos, children and parents were informed that EcoKids participants could choose to take part in the new online offering EcoTeamEurope after moving on. This created an opportunity **to continue shared learning experiences and maintain existing contacts.**

Hoffnung leben e.V. also supported Ariadni Lesbos in developing and financing joint projects, through forwarding earmarked grants and donations, as well as in connecting with funding partners and recruiting volunteers.

The regular exchange enables both organisations to share experiences, further develop programmes and respond to new challenges.

October 2025 – Impressions from one of our members visiting Ariadni Lesvos

In early October 2025, I had the opportunity to spend eleven days on Lesbos and at the Ariadni House to learn about the work of Hoffnung leben e.V. and contribute myself.



Among other things, I supported a young woman from Uganda with German exam preparation (A1) and experienced the open and heartfelt atmosphere in the house. What particularly impressed me was that all programmes begin with a shared, nourishing meal. This ensures that people can participate feeling strengthened and calm.

I also noticed the lovingly and carefully designed spaces. The large communal kitchen, creative offerings and learning opportunities create a place where people feel welcome and safe.

Above all, however, what moved me was the personal interaction of the team with visitors. Relationships emerge that are shaped by respect, trust and genuine concern, and often continue even after leaving the island – supported by the online offerings of Ariadni and Hoffnung leben e.V.

A visit to the Catholic community in Mytilini as well as conversations about the situation of refugee people on Lesbos made clear how closely personal encounters and global challenges are connected. Particularly moving was the remembrance of people who lost their lives during their flight.

My stay showed me that sustainable support goes far beyond educational programmes: community, reliability and human closeness give hope and open new perspectives.

Long-term Support Across Borders

What begins on Lesbos with a first meeting does not end for us when someone moves on. **Many contacts remain intact over many years** – regardless of whether families now live in Germany, Switzerland or another European country.

Digital educational programmes, family visits and regular personal conversations make it possible to continue relationships and support people even in new life situations. We do not orient ourselves to project timelines or national borders, but to the people and their individual needs.



Over the years, this has created a **network** shaped by **trust, reliability and mutual respect**. Especially for people whose lives have been marked for a long time by uncertainty and frequent changes, this **continuity** means more than individual offers of help. They experience that familiar contact persons remain reachable even after relocating.

The feedback from children and young people is particularly moving. A former EcoKid, who has now been living in Germany for some time, wrote to us saying they missed Lesbos – not because of the place itself, but because of the people and the community that had given them stability there. Such feedback shows **how powerful shared experiences and reliable relationships** can be.

We are now supporting some children, young people and families for around four years already. Initial contacts have developed into long-term relationships. They create trust, provide orientation and convey the feeling of not facing challenges alone.

We also learn from these encounters. The experiences and different perspectives of the people enrich our work and confirm us in cultivating long-term relationships and accompanying people respectfully and as equals on their individual paths.

Numbers, Transparency and Partnerships

Behind the projects and personal encounters are many people, volunteer commitment and responsible handling of the funds entrusted to us. The figures below provide an overview of the most important activities and framework conditions for the reporting year 2025.

Volunteer Commitment

The work of Hoffnung leben e.V. is largely sustained by **volunteer commitment**. In 2025, around 1,560 hours of voluntary work were carried out – including for project development, teaching, family support, fundraising, networking as well as board and administrative work.

Funding and Partnerships

In 2025, Hoffnung leben e.V. received grants totalling €5,000 for building the digital learning platform EcoTeamEurope and the educational programme German and Integration.

Additionally, Hoffnung leben e.V. forwarded earmarked grants of €3,000 for EcoKids Lesvos and €3,500 for purchasing food supplies for camp residents.

Furthermore, the association forwarded earmarked private donations totalling around €22,000 for activities of Ariadni Lesvos and supported the organisation with its own funds of €30,000.

Transparency

Since 2025, Hoffnung leben e.V. has been registered in the **Transparency Register**. This fulfils the legal requirements and underlines our commitment to responsible and accountable association governance.

Earmarked grants and donations for Ariadni Lesvos are forwarded exclusively in accordance with their designated purpose. To avoid potential conflicts of interest, Ursula Zednicek does not participate in decisions regarding corresponding funding due to her role at Ariadni Lesvos. These decisions are made by the remaining board members.

Financial details of the reporting year are presented in a separate financial report.

Looking Ahead

Also in 2026, we want to support people with refugee and migration experiences through education, encounter and long-term accompaniment. Building on the experiences of the past year, we will further develop our programmes according to needs.

A priority will be expanding our digital educational offerings. For **EcoTeamEurope**, a second children's and youth group is planned. At the same time, we want to expand the **Lerncafé Online** (Learning Café Online) with additional language learning programmes and extra learning levels.

Furthermore, we want to continue **growing our network of volunteers, funding partners and cooperating organisations**. Long-term secure funding remains an important prerequisite to reliably continue our work and develop new projects.

Our goal remains unchanged: accompanying people on their path to a self-determined life – through education, trust and relationships that endure even across national borders.

It is not yet possible to reliably assess what **impact the implementation of the Common European Asylum System (CEAS)** will have on our work. Already in the second half of 2025, we observed increasing returns to Greece, through which the need for support on Lesbos could rise further. We will monitor these developments closely and adapt our programmes – as far as our possibilities allow – to the changing needs.

Regardless of political and legal changes, our goal remains the same: to empower people through education, reliable relationships and practical support and to accompany them a piece of the way on their individual path.

General Facts, Background and Further Information

The topics of flight, migration and integration are often addressed emotionally and controversially in public debate. From our perspective, it is all the more important to rely on reliable information and verifiable data. This is why we refer at various points to publicly accessible sources and official reports that enable independent assessment. These include:

- Data and reports on migration and asylum,
- Official crime and education statistics,
- Publications on integration and participation in society,
- Information on the Sustainable Development Goals of the United Nations (SDGs),
- Scientific studies as well as official reports from national and international institutions.

We want to contribute to an objective discussion and invite interested parties to form a comprehensive picture themselves based on these sources.

Our practical experience shows that statistics and personal encounters complement each other: numbers help to contextualise societal developments, while individual stories make visible how people experience these developments.

As an association committed according to its statutes to the inalienability of human rights, we follow developments in Germany and Europe closely. We consider it important also to point to reports documenting shortcomings or criticism regarding the implementation of human rights obligations and discussing them publicly.

Das klappt meistens ganz gut. Da die afrikanischen Frauen aber viel extrovertierter sind, ist es für manche Themen/Angebote aber auch gut, die Gruppe aufzuteilen. Ariadni möchte ein Hauswirtschaftstraining anbieten. Dafür sind bereits Gelder vorhanden. Es wird zunehmend ein Problem sein, dass Asylanträge abgelehnt werden und Geflüchtete zurück nach Griechenland müssen. Hier setzt dieses niederschwellige Ausbildungsangebot an. Die Situation für Geflüchtete in Europa wird immer schwieriger; auch alleinstehende Frauen werden inzwischen abgelehnt. Es gibt vermehrt geschlossene Camps (auch in Deutschland). Noch gibt es keine europäischen Lösungsansätze für die Situation Geflüchteter und abgelehnter Asylbewerber. Bestrebungen wie/ob Geflüchtete in Ausbildung gebracht werden, um dem Fachkräftemangel entgegen zu wirken, sind auch nicht abzusehen. Weiterführung Kooperation mit Ariadni wird bis 31.6.26 finanziell mit 2500€ monatlich unterstützt. Beschluss aus der Vorstandssitzung (Christiane, Eva) CGU berichtet: sie war 2025 für 7 Tage bei Ariadni. Sie hat das Haus und das Team kennengelernt. Niki, das Frauenprogramm verantwortet und Ordnung und Sauberkeit sorgt, Anna die EcoKids Lehrerin, Sarah die Hospitantin. Sie hat an den Vormittagen beim Deutschunterricht unterstützt. Was ihr gleich aufgefallen ist: dass alle Angebote immer mit einem reichhaltigen Essen beginnen.

	Die Gespräche mit Ursula über die Situation auf der Insel und die der Geflüchteten waren für sie sehr interessant. Sie hat sich auch die Umgebung, die Altstadt vom Mytilini sowie das alte und neue Camp angesehen und war gemeinsam mit vielen Schwarzafrikaner*innen im Sonntagsgottesdienst. Auch hier war das Thema Flucht ganz präsent. So wurde beispielsweise für fünf auf dem Meer ertrunkenen Geflüchteten gebetet.
